


What is Dependent Eligibility Verification?

A dependent eligibility verification program (DEV) is a review of an employers health benefits plan to confirm that enrolled dependents are actually eligible to receive coverage. When enacted, this service will:

- Reduce overall healthcare costs by eliminating claims paid for ineligible dependents
- Mitigate the risk of incurring a high cost ineligible claim
- Assist firms in complying with laws and regulations related to operating a benefit plan as designed and avoiding costly fines and penalties.

Covering ineligible dependents will increase costs associated with the pandemic

Due to COVID-19, the delay of preventive care screenings and ongoing treatment services means employers will experience a large number of high-cost claimants in the future. Stop-loss carriers WILL deny any and all claims of this nature submitted on behalf of ineligible dependents.
